These simple conventions are intended to constitute a workable contract between rotating partners much like a formalized contract does between permanent partners in duplicate play. These chosen 7 conventions are:

#1. Stayman #2. Jacoby Transfers #3. Blackwood and Gerber which are kissing bridge cousins #4 two club bids #5. Double Bids #6. Preemptive Bids and #7. In/convenient Minors
