Manager's Corner

Prize Homesite Award – Exceptional landscaping has always been an integral part of a Jensen's Residential Community. Many residents go above and beyond what is expected to enhance their yards. The "Prize Home site Award" is intended to award the homeowner(s) whose yard stands out above all the rest. The award is one month's lot rental fee. At Crestwood, two winners will be picked prior to July 12, 2018. Criteria used in selecting the best home site are as follows; colorful flowers and shrubs, sharp edging around beds with mulch, pine straw, stone, etc., eye catching arrangements, exceedingly well-maintained grass, and an attractive home and utility building. Let's try to make this decision as difficult as possible for the judges!

Watering - Please remember when watering, that the UNH Cooperative Extension says it's best to water early in the morning (6AM - 10AM) and if this is not possible than to do so in the early evening (5PM - 7:30PM). Watering during the middle of the day when the weather is the hottest is just a waste of the water. The water will evaporate before it soaks into the roots of the grass.

Home site maintenance - Please remember that the spring clean up of resident home sites was supposed to be completed by May 11, 2018. The Roberts will only be picking up normal household trash. Residents are now responsible for the removal of all yard waste they decide to remove from their home sites. Jensen will only pick up branches that residents bring to the road side and we attempt to pick these up on both Mondays and Fridays. Items such as grass, rocks, garden waste and the like need to be removed by the homeowner. Also, it would be wise to clean pine needles from the roof of your home, garage or carport. Leaving these on the shingles may cause damage or lessen the life expectancy of the shingles. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

Dogs - We have been asked numerous times to remind dog owners that retractable leashes are not allowed, per the Rental Agreement. Dogs should be walked on leashes of no more than 6' in length. Also, please refrain from allowing your dog to "do their business" on others lawns or mailbox posts. It's common courtesy.

Jensen's Sales and Referrals - New home buyers are lining up to move into Crestwood however we don't have many sites to build new homes on. We currently have a limited number of homes listed for resale and are in contact daily with potential buyers about relocating to Crestwood. Please remember the Jensen Referral fee plan. If you refer someone to us and they purchase a new home from Jensen's then you will receive a referral fee equal to two months lot rent. If they purchase a brokered home through Jensen's you receive one month's rent. Also, if you are thinking about selling your home, now would be a good time to talk with Abby and Dan.
